**Registration materials are available at each school site. Parents must bring the following to register their child:**

1. original birth certificate,
2. complete and up-to-date immunization records as required by Nevada Law, and
3. proof of residency (utility bill with street address) in your neighborhood.

**You may enroll your child, however, your child may not start school until all immunizations are completed by the start of the 2019-2020 school year.**

### State of Nevada Immunization Requirements

Kindergartners and new students to the State of Nevada:

- ❖ **DTP/DT/DTAP:** 4 doses are required. A 5<sup>th</sup> dose must be given if the 4<sup>th</sup> dose was administered before the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday.
- ❖ **IPV/Polio:** 3 doses are required. A 4<sup>th</sup> dose must be given if the 3<sup>rd</sup> dose was administered before the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday.
- ❖ **MMR/Measles Mumps Rubella:** 2 doses are required. Ideally, the 1<sup>st</sup> dose is after the 1<sup>st</sup> birthday and the 2<sup>nd</sup> dose is after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday.
- ❖ **Hepatitis A:** 2 doses are required and must follow the ACIP schedule.
- ❖ **Hepatitis B:** 3 doses are required and must follow the ACIP schedule.
- ❖ **Varicella (Chicken Pox):** 2 doses are required. Ideally, the 1<sup>st</sup> dose is after the 1<sup>st</sup> birthday and the 2<sup>nd</sup> dose is after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday. If a child had a Varicella (chickenpox) diagnosis confirmed by a health care provider OR they have laboratory evidence of prior chickenpox disease, then it is not necessary to vaccinate regardless of age at time of infection.
- ❖ **TDAP (Tetanus Diphtheria Pertussis):** 1 dose is required for all students entering the 7<sup>th</sup> grade and all new students in grades 8-12.
- ❖ **MCV4 (Meningococcal Meningitis):** 1 dose is required for all students entering the 7<sup>th</sup> grade and all new students in grades 8-12.
